From today's Isaiah reading

"Look, the young woman is with child and shall bear a son"

Reflection:

As we draw close to Christmas, Isaiah's prophecy calls us to trust. Like Ahaz, we may be tempted to rely on our own strength or worldly solutions. Yet God invites us to lean instead on divine presence, even when we cannot fully understand. In Jesus, our Emmanuel, God comes quietly and humbly through Mary's faith and the Spirit's power.

So, we ask ourselves:

- † What fears, or uncertainties, make it difficult for me to trust God's promise?
- † How do I recognize the signs of "Emmanuel" – God-with-us, in my daily life?
- † How can I, like Mary, offer my own "yes" to God's will as Christmas approaches?
